15-20 minutes

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS

- Present “Industry Posters” to the class describing the information included on each
- Break students into teams
- Share and introduce students to the “Industry Poster Scavenger Hunt Worksheet”
- Students will use the posters to answer the questions and identify which industry matches which question
- Consider giving a prize to the team that finishes first with correct answers or gets them all correct
